

The Florida International Air Show Wings Reading Challenge 2019 Teacher Guidelines

In order to support reading and the STEM program, The Florida International Air Show Committee has established The Florida International Air Show Wings Reading Challenge 2019.

All elementary students (K-5) in Charlotte County are eligible to earn their wings certificate and a ticket for free admission to attend the Florida International Air Show on November 1st, 2nd or 3rd when accompanied by an adult with paid admission. To earn their wings a student must:

1. Read an interesting book about an aviation topic. The book may be read alone by the student or shared at home as a family reading activity.
2. Write about the book on the student form provided. The length of the summary or review will be determined by the teacher, but should be appropriate for the student's grade level.
3. Turn in the completed form to his or her teacher to be certified and receive a Wings Certificate and a ticket to the Florida International Air Show.

Teachers:

The contest runs from September 9th—October 15, 2019. Please tell your lead teacher the number of tickets that you need for your class. Tickets should be distributed on October 28th. Teachers with the MOST participation will receive a Family 4 pack tickets to the Air Show. 2nd & 3rd place teachers will receive 2 adult tickets.
